

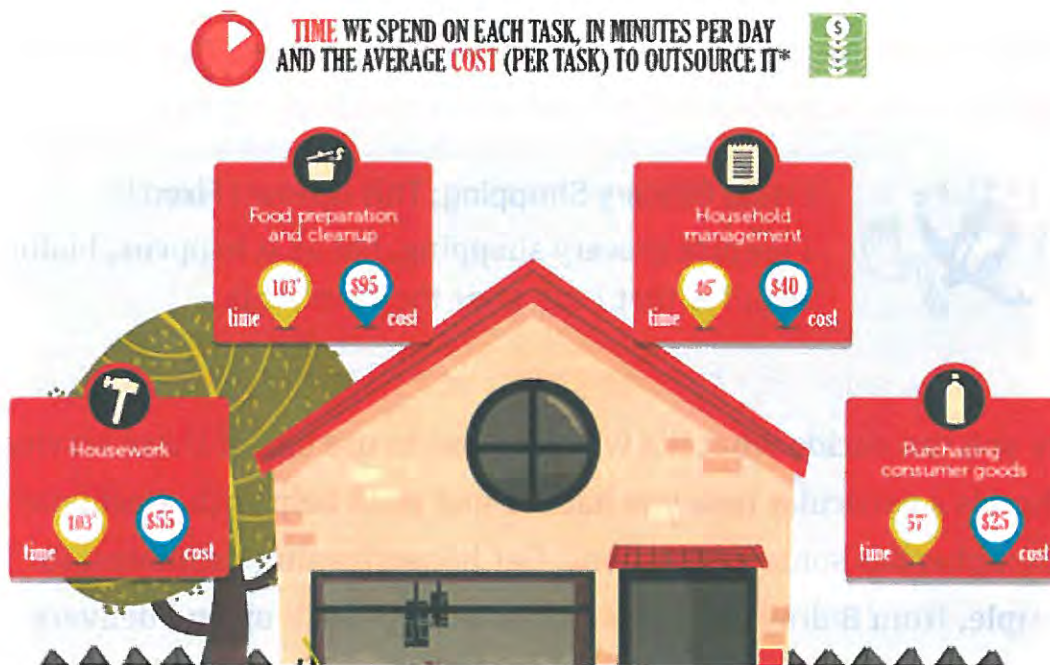
Outsource Your Chores to The Internet with These Handy Services

The graphic identifies the average time spent on household chores (a frightening 110 minutes a day on housework for women, for example) and compares it to the average cost per task to outsource it. Many of these tasks would be worth outsourcing, depending on how much your time is worth. Lawn and garden care, for example, takes an average of just over 2 hours. For \$50, you could use those 2 hours to work on a project that might earn you more. Like my fellow Lifehacker writer Thorin, I hate grocery shopping, so I use online grocery services and might even pay someone \$25 to save me from shopping hell.

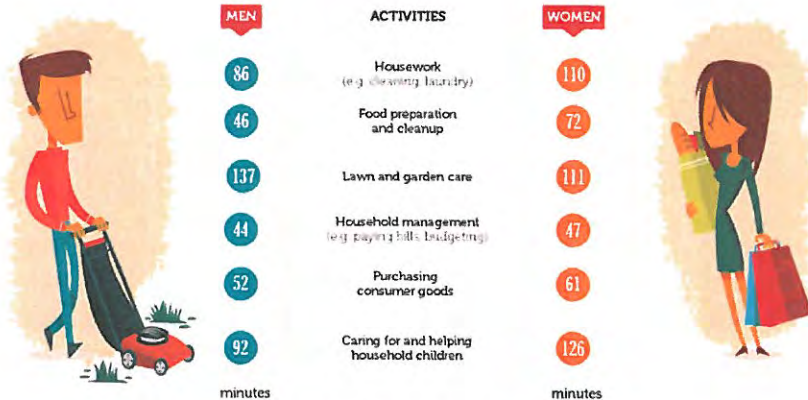
